The time is fast approaching for District Project Achievement (DPA). This is an educational competition for our 5th and 6th grade 4-H students. To participate in this competition; students must prepare a 4-6 minute oral presentation on a subject of their choice. They can use any type of visual, (posters, models, etc.). They present their demonstration in front of a panel of judges who will be observing for ease in presenting and knowledge of subject. The categories to choose from are listed on the back of this letter. In order to reserve a category, a **parent** must call the Extension Service at (770)479-0418. We can only allow two students to compete in each category. Call early to get your first choice. After sign up, we will mail a detailed letter and permission form.

On January 19, 2010 we will have a Parent Orientation & Practice Night at 4-H Office in the Historic Courthouse at 6:30. This will be a good time for Parents to learn what District Project Achievement is and what you can do to help your child have a successful presentation.

Prior to the competition we would like to see the finished project either at school or at our office. Students should bring their posters and be prepared to give their speech. Please schedule a day to come to our office, (770)479-0418 or email tchristo@uga.edu, so we can see your presentation.

Please RSVP to our office at 770-479-0418 for the parent orientation meeting. This will be extremely informative for both student and parent.

Our plans are to leave from Cherokee High School lower parking lot on Friday February 12th at 5:00 pm and return there on Saturday, February 13th at 5:00 pm. The 4-H County Extension Agent attends as the chaperone for the weekend, along with certified 4-H volunteer leaders.
